## Bridgewater Dog Owners Must License Their Dogs in June

Dog owners must license their dogs 6 months and older at the Town Clerk's office beginning June  $1^{st}$ .

## \*\*PLEASE NOTE THIS YEAR WE STRONGLY ENCOURAGE YOU TO LICENSE YOUR DOG THROUGH THE MAIL ONLY!

Please send a <u>self-addressed</u>, <u>stamped envelope</u> with a check or money order and the following information: Updated rabies vaccination certificate, owner's name, phone number, address, dog's name, breed, age, color markings, and sex. The address of the Town Clerk's Office is P.O. Box 216, Bridgewater, Connecticut 06752.

The state requires all dogs to have rabies vaccinations, so a certificate of the current shot is required. If licensing a dog for the first time, bring the spayed or neutered certificate to qualify for a lower license fee.



In order to issue a license, this form must be completed. The following items are also required: Valid rabies certificate, spay/neuter certificate (for first time licenses to receive discounted fee), Selfaddressed stamped envelope and check made out to the Bridgewater Town Clerk



Bridgewater LOVES Dogs!

All dogs over the age of 6 months are required per State Statute to have a current rabies vaccination and be licensed by June 30th every year. Beginning July 1", a penalty of \$1.00 is charged for each month the dog is unlicensed.
