## Bridgewater, CT Bid Solicitation for Sidewalk/Walkway Construction

Date of Solicitation: May 6, 2020

### Specifications:

- Sidewalk Length = approximately 300 linear feet
- Width = 48"
- Materials to include flagstone and stonedust
- Sidewalk base will be pre-prepped
- Reset existing granite portion of the sidewalk, approximately 60ft
- Location: Bridgewater Town Hall to Clapboard Rd.

### Potential contractors will be responsible for and must specify in their proposal:

- Finished edges with topsoil, grass seeding and mulch
- All work completed by September 1, 2020
- Two Year guarantee against obvious failure due to poor quality of workmanship
- Provide proof of liability insurance
- The Town of Bridgewater is a tax exempt municipality
